Another **GSF** program is **Soaring Valor**. You may find it interesting that fewer than 500,00 World War II Veterans are still with us. Through **Soaring Valor**, World War II veterans and their guardians are brought to New Orleans to tour The National WWII Museum built in their honor. Their experience includes entertainment, celebratory meals, and community building with their fellow heroes. Students who accompany our veterans continue their stories with a new appreciation for the sacrifices made by an entire generation, the Greatest Generation.
